Bluebird Meadow to O'Fallon Sports Park



The City of O'Fallon, St. Charles
County, and Great Rivers Greenway
are partnering to build a new
greenway connection between
Bluebird Meadow and O'Fallon Sports
Park.

This connection was identified as one of the nine priorities in the St. Charles County Greenway Master Plan and is an important step in closing the gap in Dardenne Greenway between Bluebird Meadow in Dardenne Prairie and Highway N in Cottleville.



This new section of the greenway will start at Bluebird Meadow and run one mile west through O'Fallon Sports Park to the Highway K shared-use path.



Project Status

The City of O'Fallon, St. Charles County, and Great Rivers Greenway have been working with the community and project partners on the preliminary design for this section of the Dardenne Greenway. This project has been awarded a federal grant through the Transportation Alternatives Program. Construction is anticipated to begin in Fall 2026. Completion of the project is anticipated in late 2027.
