Greenways are for everyone! You can walk, run, bike, push a stroller or roll a wheelchair. Or just get some fresh air.

Please use communication and kindness with other greenway visitors.

- Keep right, pass on the left with a friendly, verbal warning
- Yield to people walking, running or using a wheelchair
- Do not block path
- Obey traffic signs and laws
- Keep pets leashed and close
- Authorized vehicles only
