

Great Rivers Greenway construction bids are coming!

Project Name: Western Greenway: Greenway Realignment at Hamilton Creek (735A)

Description: This project intends to proactively prevent future damage to the existing greenway caused by erosion and slope failure. An ~800-foot section of greenway along Hamilton Creek in the City of Wildwood will be shifted ~100ft away from the streambank. Work includes removal and replacement of the existing asphalt trail, culvert and drainage reconfiguration, and native plantings.

Project Name: Brickline Greenway: Spring Ave between Page and Lindell Blvds (308S)

Description: The 0.75-mile greenway project includes two separate and federally funded phases and must comply with MoDOT's Local Public Agency requirements (Phase 2 TAP-9901(688) and Phase 3 TAP-5401(721)). Prospective bidders are encouraged to review and submit bids for both Phase 2 and Phase 3. The project includes, but is not limited to: earthwork, removals, grading, paving, utility adjustments, street reconfiguration, traffic control, signals, street and pedestrian lighting, sidewalk, curbs, unit pavers, granite, trees, landscaping, and site furniture and includes furnishing all material, labor, tools, equipment, and supervision necessary for project construction.

Project Name: Meramec Greenway: Unger County Park Realignment (247A)

Description: This project includes improvements to the Meramec Greenway segment in Unger County Park that has experienced extensive flood damage. This project develops a trail alignment that relocates and elevates the existing trail to minimize repeated flood damage in the future. The project also includes improvements such as a new trailhead parking lot, native plantings along the greenway, a redesigned roadway intersection within the park to improve vehicular and trail user safety and two trail overlooks with views of the Meramec River.

Project Name: Meramec Greenway: Signage Replacement Project (725K)

Description: This project will replace existing GRG wayfinding signage in Eureka from Lion's Park near Downtown Eureka to Route 66 State Park.

Project Name: Hodiamont Greenway: Goodfellow to Belt (288A)

Description: This quarter-mile segment will be developed with access to St. Vincent Greenway and will feature design elements of the greenway corridor and intersection treatment that will set a precedent for future phases of greenway development. This area is nestled in the alleyway of a residential neighborhood, which historically operated as a streetcar and then bus line. This will convert the alleyway into a hard surface trail with pedestrian focused amenities, including elements of placemaking and safety. The Goodfellow Blvd intersection will remain the same while the Belt Ave intersection will be reconfigured to prioritize pedestrian and driver safety. Proposed improvements will include the greenway, minor street intersection improvements, raised crosswalks, landscaping, signage, and site furnishings. The project includes, but is not limited to: trenching, boring, earthwork, removals, grading, paving, utility adjustments, intersection reconfiguration, site prep & construction of play equipment, pedestrian lighting, trees, landscaping, and site furniture.

Project Name: Centennial Greenway: Dielman Rd to Olive Blvd (599B)

Description: In the City of Olivette, this project will extend the Centennial Greenway 0.85 miles from the intersection of Olive Blvd and North Price Road to Dielman Road, including a former Union Pacific Railroad parcel, and connect two segments constructed in 2024.
